Our first full week of school is in the books. I am proud of the effort our students are putting in. Whether it is journaling, breaking down complex math problems, working in groups, or learning new sounds; the students are truly back into school mode. One of our biggest changes is in the 8th grade. Six of our 8th graders were afforded the opportunity to take an Honor Biology Class at Lawrenceburg High School.
